Peter Guindon (Yandeu/Yandaw) born 1770? Moscovtown Quebec died before 1830
married Mary Frances ?????

Joseph b 1 Jun 1800, Que m Marie Griffin abt 1830 d 2 Dec 1876

From 1763 to 1764 Quebec extended to the *Ohio River* therefore you may find some of your **Guindon** connections in records in the U.S. There are some Guindons listed in the *St. Henre de Mascouche Catholic Church, Quebec. The History of Addison County, Vermont* gives a sketch of Nicholas H. Guindon of Lincoln, born New Haven Vermont, son of Gabriel Guindon, born in the town of Moscow P.Q of French Canadian parents. According to Vermont vital records Gabriel died 26 Sep 1869 age 63 yrs 4 mos 24 days, farmer, born Moscow C.E. father Peter Guindon mother Mary F of Lincoln twp. He was a member of the Society of Friends (Quakers).
