## ***The "Guindon" Connection***

The following information was shared by Arlene Hood Jan 21 1997

In the last newsletter Nov 96 #11 in the Descendants of Francois Guindon it lists *Augustin Guindon 1734-1756 as married to Archange Sayan. (editor SOURCE - Tanguay)*

I have the wedding record of Louis Augustin son of Paul Guindon and Therese Lauzon from Ste Rose, Quebec of 1809. It has their wedding listed as Archange (Dagnan, Sayan) Vaillancourt. I had a researcher check on it and she said they are all the same person.

Also, according to my records Archer Guindon 1823-1897 who married Henrietta Cahier (Cayer Caille) 31 Jan 1831 at L'Original ON had a son Israel Guindon who married Josephine Laroque and they had three children

My number one problem with the Guindon line continues to be the marriage record of my grandfather, Joseph Guindon with my grandmother Marguerite Couture (Charles and Zoe Brisibois), who was baptized Nov 7, 1856 at St. Simon-Jude church in Belle River, Ontario. In the actual parish record the priest spells her name as Couturier, but in other records the family is referred to as Couture. The same parish records show no other records for the family after Marguerite's birth, which leads me to the belief that they moved elsewhere. The local parish, St. Joseph's in Bay City MI is hostile to genealogists (with the backing of the Saginaw Diocese) and will not help. Although all of their children were born in Bay City, the Bay county clerk's records give no marriage there. No family members remain who can help. We simply don't know where to look for them when they got married. This is holding up my research into the Couture line.

My 3G Grandparents Pauliene Guindon and Louis Beaulieu emigrated from Canada to Upstate New York. They were married on the 21st of January in 1850, in Hogansburg, NY. They resided during their married lives in Bombay, Franklin County, New York. Her maiden name shows up in various records as either GUINDON or YADDOW. She was the daughter of Jean Baptiste Guindon and Angelique Vaillancourt-Benoit. Her birthdate was 28 July 1826 in Beauharnois, Quebec. Louis Beaulieu was from Boucherville, Que. He was the son of Louis Hudon dit Beaulieu and Julie Vallee. Her uncle, Alexander, moved to Bombay, NY from Ste.Marthe, Que. His children settled in the Franklin and St Lawrence Counties area of New York State. There are still YADDOWs in that area

1. Visit to Hammond Golf and Country Club ACTION/DEADLINE

We met with Ernest Leonard and Josee Pigeon regarding the use of their banquet hall for the long weekend in August, year 2000. Facilities are available for 200 or 400 people ( a deposit of \$300 or \$500 required one year prior to the event).

We discussed the possibility of a banquet supper on the Saturday evening (cocktails at 18:00, dinner at 19:00 hours) and a Brunch the following Sunday morning (11:30-13:30) after the Family Mass.

We all found the facilities to be excellent, in a brand new building, with room for expansion if the need arises. Displays could be left in the banquet hall overnight. Several menu options available - hot and cold buffet, hip of beef, barbeque steak with buffet, etc. (around \$17.00 per person). Half price for children aged 5-9 years and free for children under 5 years. There is no other facility nearby that could accommodate a large crowd.
