The “Guindon Connection”

Pam found us on the Guindon Web Page – <http://www3.sympatico.ca/rquindon>
Here is what she shared with us – possibly you can make a connection?

My great grandfather Francis has only one living child out of 10 children. I have a few stories that were given to me on my grandfather's early life. My one aunt writes that the only information she has on her father is that he had several brothers and sisters and the only ones she knows of are the four children of Elie Guindon and Maude LeFleur Guindon. The last she knew that 3 of them lived in Portland, Oregon and one in Longview, Washington. My great grandfather Francis Napoleon Guindon was born on July 16, 1854 in Hudson, Quebec, Canada.

Other records that I have show that when he was eight years old his father had him go to work in a lumber mill, miles from home and he was injured and one leg was shorter than the other. It also states that a few years later he migrated to the United States and was in Chicago at the time of the “Big Fire.” In 1871 he accompanied the Detroit Fire Company to the burning city. I have a record that shows when he was 12 years old he moved to Michigan at the time of the big fire and remained for several years and then moved to Niagara Falls and was engaged in farming. He married Sarah Morrison in 1881 in Apple River Illinois. They moved to South Dakota in 1884.

We have been having a reunion every 5 years since 1980 and it is held in Plankinton, South Dakota. We are planning another reunion in August of the year 2000. It is kind of ironic that we would both be scheduling a reunion at the same time. We started out in 1980 with our first reunion and had about 150 people and we started with a dance and a potluck picnic and had lots of fun visiting. In 1985 we had our second reunion and did pretty much the same thing and we all had T-shirts made with the Guindon Reunion on it and in 1990 we made a Guindon Cookbook. I had everyone send favorite recipes. In 1995 we had a barbecue at our home for my grandfather's family and had about 100 people at our home, it was a lot of fun. We also had a dance and potluck picnic. We are looking forward to the year 2000 for our next reunion but on a sad note we have lost some relatives that are very near and dear to our hearts so it will be kind of difficult with them not being here. They will be

in our thoughts during that weekend. We are a very close knit family.

My great grandfather had 10 children and they all had large families so we have a large bunch of us. The only family that we know is that of my great grandfather's children. We never found any of my great grandmother's family.

My great grandfather was a small man and his children were all small also. My grandfather Johnnie only weighed about 80 pound ringing wet. He loved horses and would drive the horses into town and give everyone a ride - that was over 30 years ago though.

I think it would be great fun to attend the Guindon Reunion in Canada. I will have to see how things go. I have a cousin that lives near and he is interested in our family tree and I can't wait to get a hold of him and let him know what I have found out.

I hope that this information will help you and if I can be of any further help let me know. I will go through my pictures and see what I can find to send up and yes you may put it in your newsletter that we are having a family reunion in South Dakota. I am not sure of the dates yet but as we find them out I will let you know.

I look forward to hearing from you and finding out about my relatives.

- Add your e-mail address to the bottom of your home page

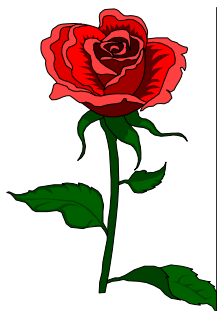

REPORT FROM THE PLANNING COMMITTEE on the FAMILY REUNION TO BE HELD AUGUST 4-6, 2000

FINANCIAL REPORT \$\$

To date 92 pre-registrations have been received (\$490) of which \$321.00 has gone towards the deposit on the banquet hall at the Hammond Golf and Country Club. A balance of \$200.00 is due in 1999. The general account has a balance of \$600.00, which covers the costs of newsletter mailings twice a year (approximately \$150.00 per mailing). Lorraine Yandon, the Treasurer, reports that newsletter membership renewals are down this year and there has been some confusion as to where to send the pre-registration fees versus the newsletter fees. Lorraine has also stepped down as Treasurer due to family obligations.

The Committee therefore recommends the amalgamation of the two accounts effective immediately. Mr. Roland Guindon, who is responsible for the pre-registration account will now become the Treasurer. The \$5.00 pre-registration fee is being collected to raise the deposit funds.
