Our Goal

Is to serve as a communicator for researching and tracing the Guindon Family history. Our primary focus will be the ancestors and descendants of Francois Guedon & Marie Mollay's son, Pierre Guindon, born 24 Sep 1662, St. Pierre du Marche, Ville du Loudun, township Chaelleraut, diocese Poitiers, Poitou, France.

On the 21st of November 1706 Pierre married Catharine Rouchellet-Braza (widow of Vincellet) at the Notre Dame Church in Montreal, Quebec.

He died on the 26 of September 1733 at St. Francois Ile Jésus, Quebec.

Ghislaine Guindon of St. Gabriel de Brandon, Quebec went to the Archives in Loudun, France and photocopied the birth records of the "Guédon" family. (Some of this information was printed in the "Guindon Newsletter" Nov 1996 page 4 acquired by Amy Agar of Victoria B.C. from Loudun, France.)

Pierre Guédon/Guindon

Pierre and his brother, Jean Guindon came from Saint-Pierre-du-Martray Parish, Loudun, France to "New France" as a volunteer. On August 6, 1688 François Hazeur, who had a tradesman service in Quebec, hired Pierre to work at the water mill under construction in Malbaie.

Jean was hospitalized in 1689, 1693 and 1696 at Hotel-Dieu (hospital) Quebec. Jean Guindon decided to go back to France in 1696.

Pierre fled France due to religious wars and to the pestilence (epidemic disease/plague) according to the archivist of Loudun, France.

According to Pierre's pre-arranged agreement, Pierre married Catherine Barsa or Breza (born 1679), on November 21, 1706 in Montreal. (Catherine's father's

name was André Barza dit Lafleur and her mother: Françoise Pilois.) Three children were born from their union between 1707 and 1710, in St-François-de-Sales, Jesus Isle. Catherine Barsa died while giving birth to her third son, Paul, on August 21, 1710.

On February 15, 1711, Pierre signed a marriage agreement with Anne Charbonneau (Guillaume Labelle's widow), witnessed by Senet, the notary public. It seems that this marriage agreement was cancelled, because the religious wedding did not take place.

Pierre died September 26, 1733; buried September 27, 1733, in St-François-de-Sales cemetery

- 1636 Jan. 15 Isle Jesus and other small adjacent islands, were granted to the Jesuits as fief and seigneurie from the New France Company. This island was called "de Montmagny", after the New France governor and one of the New France Company directors.
- 1706 St. Francois Parish built close to the Seigneurial Manor and Saint Mathieu Chapel, and Enfant-Jesus Chapel
- 1716 The first banal mill (the people paid a fee to the lord to use the mill) was situated on the Rivière-des-Prairies, to the west of the principal manor, between a small rocky island and Isle Jesus.
- 1735 St. François Mill was joined to the north bank of the river of the island via "Montée du Moulin"
- 1721 Fire destroyed Banal Mill, Seigneurial Manor, and the Enfant-Jesus Chapel

Paul died October 5, 1748, 38 years-old, buried October 6, 1748. Witnesses: Louis Laberge, Charles Aubé, Antoine Curon, Michel Chabot; Officiant: Poulin.

Paul married 16 Nov 1733 Marie-Joseph Aubé

He married Amable Maisonneuve (Jacques Charboneau's widow), January 12, 1761, Ste-Rose.
3. Marie-Geneviève, born January 1737; christened January 2, 1737 St-François-de-Sales; godfather: Charles Aubé; godmother: M.-Geneviève Dazé; witness: the midwife; Officiant: (J.-Baptiste) Poulin.
4. Nicolas, born October 27, 1738; christened October 27, 1738, St-François-de-Sales; godfather: Nicolas Réaume, godmother: Geneviève Doyon; witness: the midwife; Officiant: Poulin, priest-vicar. He first married Isabel Duquet (Jos & Isabelle Charbonneau's daughter), January 23, 1755, St-Eustache and secondly, married M. Clémence (Leduc & Pascal Berthalet's daughter), October 17, 1808.

Our French Ancestors And Their Occupations.

In Loudun, France, there were three main branches of Guedons. One branch specialized in making hat/bonnets, the second were shoemakers and the third branch were butchers. Our ancestors were butchers as was Pierre Guedon (Guindon) who came over to Canada at the age of 21 years with his older brother Jean. There is no further trace of Jean and it is supposed he died on the trip or returned to France. Pierre is the only one from the Loudun region who stayed in Canada. Many others settled mainly in Acadia (the Maritimes) but returned to France before the mass deportation.

A Loudun en France aux temps de ses ancêtres, il y avait des Guédon qui faisait partie de trois différentes confréries. Il y avait les chapeliers qui confectionnaient les chapeaux, les cordonniers pour les chaussures et les bouchers pour toutes les sortes de bétails. Ses ancêtres à elle étaient des cordonniers. Pierre était lui-même boucher. Il avait environ 21 ans lorsqu'il a quitté la France et son frère aîné qui s'appelait Jehan serait parti avec lui. Toutefois on a jamais retrouvé trace de lui dans les registres et on suppose qu'il serait mort sur le bateau. Pierre Guédon est le seul de la ville de Loudun qui soit parti au Canada et soit demeuré au Canada. Plusieurs de cette région sont allés surtout en Acadie et sont retournés en France avant la déportation des Acadiens.
