Pierre died on the 26 of September 1733 at St. Francois Ile Jésus, Quebec.

Research has been done to find **Francois Napoleon Guindon's** parents. It appears documents have referenced the place of his birth as Hudson, Province, Quebec.

If you look on this map from www.mapquest.ca you will see that Hudson, Quebec is very close to Ste. Marthe, Quebec where **Francois Napoleon Guindon** was born. His parents **Olivier Guindon** and ***Sebline Pilon** were married 20 Oct 1847 Ste Marthe, Vaudreuil Co. Quebec. (Just below and to the left of Hudson – marked with a red star)



MARRIAGE OF THEODORE GUINDON AND MARGUERITE BRASEAU 1823

On January 2, 1823, after publication of marriage, done on three consecutive Sundays, **Theodore Guindon**, major son of **Gabriel Guindon**, and deceased **Marianne Rousee dit Martel**, of this parish on one part, and **Marguerite Braseau**, minor daughter of **Gabriel Braseau** and **Marie Gauthier** of this parish on the other part, seeing that there is no objection to their future marriage, I the undersigned, priest of this parish, with the mutual agreement of both parties, have given them the nuptial benediction, in the presence of **Gabriel Guindon**, father of the groom, **Theophile Guindon**, his brother, **Francois Guindon**, his uncle, **Charles Blais**, **Paul Braseau**, **Gabriel Braseau**, father of the bride, **Louis Wellet** and **Gabriel Wellet** who declared that they cannot sign.

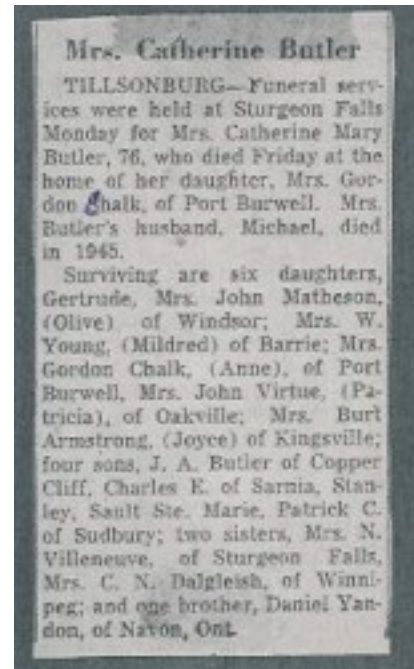
MRS. CATHERINE BUTLER 1880 - 1956

Important to Parents

It was lately ruled in the Court of King's Bench, in a case "Wilker v Law" that the entry of the birth, in a baptismal register, is not evidence to prove the age of the party. It is nothing more than something told to the clergyman at the time of christening, concerning which he has not power by law to make an entry in the register. In this case the Defendant was christened in 1807, but the entry stated that he was born in 1799. This verdict should be a caution to parents to comply with the Rubric, in not deferring the baptism of their children longer than the first or second Sunday after their birth, as the most important questions in our courts of justice often turn against them.
